ATV ADVENTURE

Tour on the East Cape

Pick-up: 8:30 am

Tour departure: 9:00am

Duration: 2 ½ hour

Return to Hotel: 11:30 am

Description

Arriving at the location you will be given a briefing by the tour guides introducing the ATV and explaining how to handle the vehicle. ATVs will be assigned and you will be provided with the necessary equipment (helmet, bandana & goggles).

Your group will be accompanied by professional guides, who carry a cooler with bottled water, and a paramedic. Leaving the location on ATVs, guides, one in the front and one in the back, will take you onto a paved road until you reach the East Cape after about 10 minutes. Here starts the exciting off-road adventure.

You will ride 20 minutes down a dirt road next to crystal waters and will get to 'Punta Gorda' overlooking the charming coastline of the Sea of Cortez, where you can observe migrating Humpback and Grey whales in season (January through March).

After another 15 minutes ride on the dirt road you will arrive at the sand dunes, where you will be given 30 minutes to explore the beauty of Los Cabos on pre-existing trails. Note that it is strongly prohibited to leave those as the area is frequently visited by turtles leaving their eggs. The way back to the location takes you through 30 minutes through the desert on trails leaving to a dried riverbed. You will get in touch with the local flora and fauna and will enjoy panoramic views. Explore the 'Arroyo Encantado' for 20 minutes on your own and feel the atmosphere of the desert.

End your tour with another 15 minutes ride on the dirt road and 10 minutes following a paved road until reaching your point of origin at 11:30 am.

Getting off the ATV you will be served cold towels to freshen up and can use restrooms available before leaving for your transfer back to the hotel at about 11:45 am.

Note: Participants must be 18 years old with a valid driver license. They can accommodate two participants on one ATV vehicle. This activity is not recommended for pregnant women.

Description:

Arriving at the location you will be given a briefing by the tour guides introducing the ATV and explaining how

to handle the vehicle. ATVs will be assigned and you will be provided with the necessary equipment (helmet, bandana & goggles).

Your group will be accompanied by professional guides, who carry a cooler with bottled water, and a paramedic. You will leave the location crossing a bridge leading over a dried riverbed. Following a trail downwards into the riverbed you will get to a training course, where you have 15 minutes to get familiar with the ATV.

The group will enjoy a 30 minutes adventurous ride through the beauty of the arroyo heading towards natural water springs situated in a small canyon. Here you will get off the vehicles to take some pictures in the rocks and in front of the water springs in order to keep a memory of this unique experience.

After this 15 minutes break you will be on the ATV for about 40 minutes taking sandy trails through the desert leading to beach where you can play around with your vehicle riding up and down the beach and into the sand dunes for approximately 1 hour.

After 20 minutes following trails through the arroyo you will arrive back to the location, where the tour started.

Getting off the ATV you will be served cold towels to freshen up and can use restrooms available before leaving for your transfer back to the hotel at about 12:15 pm.

Note: Participants must be 16 years old with a valid driver license. They can accommodate two participants on one ATV vehicle. This activity is not recommended for pregnant women.

HORSEBACK RIDING

Description:

Arriving to the location at 8:50 am, you will meet with guides, who will give you instructions according to the individual experience of riders taking the tour. Horses will be assigned according to the pre-existing knowledge of participants.

The tour starts at 9:00 am horseback riding through a small trail surrounded by palm trees and crossing to the famous and legendary San Jose Estuary, where you will discover a diversity of flora and fauna, having the opportunity to see many kinds of birds that use to come to Cabos from the north. After 20 minutes you arrive at the beach and will enjoy riding along the coastline of the Sea of Cortez for about 35 minutes before returning to your point of origin.

Description:

Arriving to the location you will meet with professional guides, who will give you instructions according to the individual experience of riders taking the tour. Horses will be assigned according to the pre-existing knowledge of participants.

Before going on the actual tour you will be able to practice on a trail next to the stable in order to get familiar with the horse.

You will leave to the backside of the stables on trail taking you directly in the majestic desert heading towards the mountains. Along the way you will see iguanas, lizards, wild rabbits, birds, all kind of desert vegetation, such as cactus, aloe vera, and various species of the agaves.

Riding through the desert for about 30 minutes you will arrive to a small canyon of rock formations, where you might have the chance to observe people rappelling up the rock wall. You will have 5 minutes to get off the horse, rest your legs and take beautiful pictures of the impressive landscape before starting on the way back to the location.

Desert trails will lead you back to the stables allowing you to admire the tranquility of the desert and in the horizon you will even see the coastline and the Sea of Cortez.

Tour Enrichment

Adding one hour to the existing tour allows you to take a ride through the mountains and the Arroyo San Carlos, once passing by the small canyon. The arroyo is a dry riverbed, but due to its closeness to the mountain you will often find water running through increasing the diversity of vegetation.

Note: Maximum weight of participants should be 250 pounds (115 kg) and extremely tall individuals should contact us to verify availability.

San José del Cabo, Glass Factory & Cabo San Lucas

Description :

Your first transfer will bring you to San José del Cabo approaching downtown by passing through the tourist zone of the town and arriving at around 9:15 am.

You will visit the mission of San José and the town square, where your guide will spend about 20 minutes explaining about the Spanish colonization and the history of the region, such as Indian tribes and missions along the Baja Peninsula.

Afterwards you will be given 1 hour for shopping and strolling through downtown. Your tour guide will provide you with directions to shops and will personally take you to recommended ones. The mission will be your meeting place for getting together after shopping.

After a short drive of 20 minutes, your second stop of about 40 minutes will be at the Arts & Crafts Center featuring the glass-blowing factory located in the tourist corridor. Note that credit cards are not accepted, yet you can pay cash in dollars or pesos.

Admire the artisans who have perfected this ancient tradition, creating custom-designed figurines of animals, flowers, glassware and more. The one-of-a kind boutiques are each stocked with artifacts and hand-crafted items created by expert artisans from all over Mexico.

Your transfer to Cabo San Lucas will take about 20 minutes arriving to the Mexican (flea) market at the Marina, where you can find arts and crafts from all over the country, such as pottery, silver, and carved wood. Feel free to consult your tour guide for any doubts concerning quality or price of your favorite souvenir. You will have 1 hour at leisure at the market.

Afterwards your guide will take you to visit the main square of Cabo San Lucas, where you will have 10 minutes to admire the skeleton of a Grey whale. Another transfer of 5 minutes will bring you to the mall 'Puerto Paraiso', featuring souvenir shops side by side with designer shops. You will have 30 minutes to shop at this upscale location and will meet back with your tour guide for transfer back to the hotel at 1:45 pm at the main entrance.

Description:

Air-conditioned transportation will bring you to San José del Cabo approaching downtown by passing through the tourist zone of the town and arriving at around 9:45 am. You will visit the mission of San José and the town square, where your guide will spend about 15 minutes explaining about the Spanish colonization and the history of the region, such as Indian tribes and missions along the Baja Peninsula.

At around 10:00 am you will be given 1 hour for shopping and strolling through downtown. Your tour guide will provide you with directions to shops and will personally take you to recommended ones. The mission will be your meeting place for getting together after shopping and heading for the restaurant where cooking classes will take place.

Arriving to the restaurant you will be greeted by the chef walked to the assigned area and offered a drink for refreshment. You will be given brochures featuring authentic recipes and general information about the event.

Your cooking class will start out with a 20 minute session on mixing and tasting Margaritas flavored with Lime and Tamarindo. Afterwards you will have 10 minutes to ask general questions and to get ready to put your hands on. Your first task will be to chop up corn tortillas and to fry them preparing Mexican chips. You will then mix an authentic Guacamole dip to accompany the chips and get those out of the fryer. A freshly prepared hot salsa will add the Mexican spice to your dish.

In a 15 minutes session you will mix the dough for and make the quesadillas, including grilling them.

After slightly more than 1 hour of preparation time you will be ready to fix up the dishes and start on the tasting of your Mexican menu. There will be time for questions & answers and the chef will have some helpful final comments for you.

At around 2:00 pm you will be finished with lunch and being transferred back to the hotel, arriving at around 2:30 pm.

Description:

Leaving the hotel you will process towards Cabo San Lucas in order to get around the tip and meet with the wide Pacific Ocean. You

will get familiar with the diverse local flora and fauna enjoying panoramic views over the ocean and the cacti desert.

Arriving to Todos Santos, approximately at 9:45 am, you will visit a Botanic Garden for about 30 minutes that hosts a great array of desert plants of which many have long-standing traditions serving in medical issues.

At around 10:15 am you will be transferred into downtown Todos Santos for a one-hour tour around the village, including a stop at the Centro Intercultural Siglo XXI (museum), the mission, and local architecture. The museum shows the history of Todos Santos and disposes of ancient pictures of the area, as well as some fossils and bones.

After finishing sight-seeing at approximately 11:15 am you will be free to stroll through downtown and enjoy shopping at some local artisans or stopping by one of the unique art galleries. You will have about 2 hours at leisure.

Todos Santos is a quaint, tranquil Mexican town that attracts local as well as international artists. You will find a variety of small art galleries exposing paintings, sculptures and other art work that are open from 11:00 am. The beauty about Todos Santos with its shops, flea market and galleries is the spirit and atmosphere of the village that is said to be the inspiration for many of the artists with residence there.

You will meet for your return transfer at approximately 1:15 pm.

Once on this side of the peninsula you can admire the Pacific Ocean from a variety of beaches. Stopping by will allow you to take a walk in the fine sand and get your feet freshened up in the cool water of the ocean.

Leaving the hotel you will process to the north for about 1 hour, passing the airport driving in between the Sea of Cortez and the mountain line.

Your first stop of 20 minutes will be at Buena Vista, a hill overlooking the East Cape and the perfect setting for taking pictures. Your guide will give you an introduction about the geography, history, as well as the flora and fauna of the Baja Peninsula.

A 30 minutes transfer through beautiful desert landscape with wide dried riverbeds brings you to San Bartolo, an old, rural, and authentic village located in a canyon, where you will find all kinds of traditional sweets and you

will be given explanations on preparation of those. Your guide will take you to a regional, old-fashioned coffee shop that also serves typical Mexican food and snacks that you are welcome to take with you to eat on the way.

After spending about 30 minutes in San Bartolo, the tour will take you 15 minutes passing through San Antonio and stopping at El Triunfo; both are historic mining towns from the late 17th and early 18th century. A 15 minutes transfer will bring you to the Cactus Valley, where you will be able to get close to a large diversity of cactus home to the Baja Peninsula, including some endemic species. You will have 1 hour to explore the valley on pre-existing trails finding out about the flora and fauna of the desert.

At around 12:30 pm you will depart the location for transfer back to the hotel, which will take about 90 minutes, arriving at the hotel at approximately 2:00 pm

area. You can visit the local mission and will meet back at the restaurant at 2:00 pm.

After a short transfer of 10 minutes, follows a visit to the Aquarium, where you will have 30 minutes to observe a great variety of tropical fish and marine mammals of the Sea of Cortez.

The last attraction you will be visiting in La Paz is the gorgeous Bay of Balandra located about 15 minutes far from the Aquarium. On the way you will pass by a natural lagoon hosting a labyrinth of mangroves. Arriving to the most beautiful beach of the area you will have the chance to swim and play for about 40 minutes in the crystal clear, calm waters of this unique place settled in between the desert and rocky mountains.

You will leave the bay at around 3:40 pm heading back towards Los Cabos traveling on the Pacific side of the Baja Peninsula and arriving at the hotel at around 6:00 pm

Leaving the base camp the tour will take you on a 5 hour ride on all-terrain Safari vehicles through the back roads of the Baja where you will explore the hidden wonders of the Peninsula.

The tour starts out taking you to 'La Barrosa', a rural area hosting farms, where you can admire a display of fossilized marine animals, laying on the ground for millions of years.

From there the tour heads towards 'Miraflores', a small village famous for artisans working on leather products. You will have the chance to look at an array of art pieces and will be explained the process of how they are produced.

Leaving the location you will process to a close mountain range where you will spend about 90 minutes, getting off the vehicle to hike up some trails that will take you to discover the ancient culture of the Pericue Tribes visiting their rock paintings. Those are located in a small canyon where you also will find refreshing water ponds and you will have time to play or swim in the natural waters.

The tour back to the base camp will again take you through the beautiful nature of the desert and you will be able to observe the local flora and fauna, including amazing species of local birds.

At Pelican Rock and Neptune's Finger you will see tropical fish, such grouper, California needlefish, Barber fish, yellow snapper, giant damselfish, balloon fish and bray bar grunt.

At Land's End you will also have the opportunity to admire manta and sea lions.

At around 10:00 am you will be ready to get into the Ocean and start your surf adventure. Your first challenge will be to get into a standing position on the board. For that purpose, you will lie down on the board, your coach will push you onto a small wave and you will be experimenting the best way for you to get up. The excitement will keep you going and you will feel the sensation of having wings to fly. Once you can keep your balance and feel comfortable on the board, you can move on to the second level, taking you to experience more of the ocean and its natural forces.

After about an hour you will get back on the beach for a 15 minutes break and can relax or take a walk to reload your energy level and start your second round.

At around 12:00 pm you will have had a lot of fun and a great experience to take back to the hotel.
